Ensure Race/Ethnicity Filters Are Compatible with Detailed DHC-B

Tip: Select the <u>year</u> and <u>survey</u> filters *before* selecting race/ethnicity filters



If you try to select race and ethnicity filters first, you will see all possible options. Filters can change over time: Example: "Navajo alone" is for 2000 Census data; "Navajo Nation alone" is for 2020 Census data


Transition From American FactFinder




